Dates: 1832-1834

Items listed as sold:

- Food items such as coffee, rice, sugar, ginger, flour, sacks of salt, herring bones, tea, whiskey, wheat.
- Various items including nails, powder, bars of steel, oil, cotton, candles
- shoes.

Transportation for goods included the boats, “Delaware” and “Randolph”, etc.

Historical Information:

John Tyler was a Scottsville merchant as early as 1832 when he authored this ledger. John was born about 1807 in Hanover Co., VA: and was the son of William and Elizabeth Tyler¹. John married Emily Susan Grove on 06 April 1833 in Albemarle County, VA². According to the 1850 Federal Census of Scottsville, John and Emily were the parents of Mary, William, Sylvester, Emma, and Erastus Tyler³. John Tyler died on 25 October 1869 in Richmond, VA.²
