Historical Information:

1820 U.S. Census searches on the 7 names contained in this ledger identified the following locations that may or may not help determine the location of the tobacco business detailed in this ledger"

- William L. Clark, Lynchburg, Campbell, VA. Household contained 3 free white persons and 5 slaves; 1 individual was involved in agriculture¹.
- John Moss, Buckingham, Nelson, VA. Household contained 9 free white persons and 12 slaves; 6 individuals were involved in agriculture².
- Richard Pollard, Buckingham, Nelson, VA. Household contained 8 free white persons and 9 slaves; 6 individuals were involved in agriculture³.
- Henry Rieves (sic), New Canton, Buckingham, VA. Household contained 7 free whites and 15 slaves; 1 person engaged in agriculture⁴.
