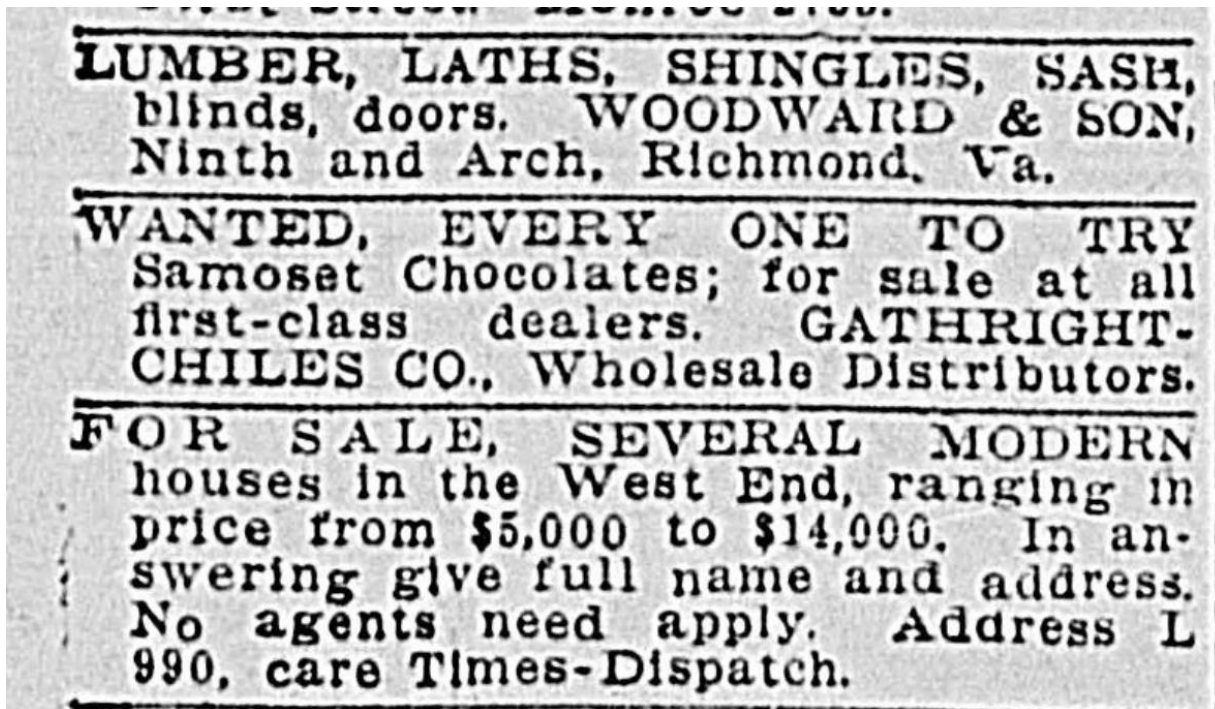

Items listed as sold:

- Food goods such as sugar, tomatoes, flour, coffee, potatoes, apples, corn eggs, tobacco, lard, butter.
- Hardware and supplies including nails, hooks, staples, oil and gas.
- Clothing such as shoes, suspenders, buttons, collar, and ties.
- General items including envelopes, paper, and matches.

Historic Information:

The businesses listed within this ledger are primarily located in Scottsville and Richmond, Virginia. Companies such as the Stephen Putney Shoe Company, Etchinson Hat Company, and Gathright-Chiles Company, are a few of the notable Richmond companies. In this newspaper edition of *The Times-Dispatch*: Richmond, VA., Sunday, July 24, 1910, an advertisement for the Gathright-Chiles Company, Wholesale Distributors, is included (see photograph below)¹. Transactions with this company are listed within this 1906-1907 Scottsville business ledger.



Unknown Daybook, September 1906 – June 1907

An additional prominent Richmond business listed within this ledger is the Virginia-Carolina Hardware Company. This company was founded by John Benjamin Pinder, who served as executive head of this company and president of the Richmond Buggy Manufacturing Company. The Virginia-Carolina Hardware Company was one of the largest companies in its line of business in the state of Virginia in the early 1900s².
